**\*\*Any Candidate that fails to meet passing requirements for the final practical skill stations or the class final written exam, will NOT BE ALLOWED to attend the State practical or National Registry test.**

The passing grade for class final written exam is 70%, and the candidate MUST pass all six in-class final practical skill stations.\*\*

**Class Requirements:**

Ride time and clinical observation time will be scheduled with Charlotte Hungerford Hospital during the course. Ten patient assessments must be completed prior to course completion.

Additionally, IS-100 - (ICS 100) Introduction to Incident Command System, IS-200 (ICS 200) ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents, IS-700 National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction, and IS-800 National Response Framework, An Introduction WILL be incorporated into this class. Students May complete on their own, free of charge by visiting <http://training.fema.gov/IS/NIMS.asp>. Presentation of certificates of completion is required before state testing.

All tests will be online and completed outside of class. They will become available on the date listed in the syllabus and remain available for 2 days after.
